

#3 - FREE DENTISTRY DAYS





If you know you don't have insurance, go ahead and skip to #5. However, if you have dental insurance, or are looking to acquire dental insurance, read on:


This might seem like a no-brainer, but we had to include insurance on this list because the biggest downfall we see with dental insurance is that people are throwing their money away!
