

#2 - In-house Savings Plans



Often times, your dental cleanings and routine dental visits are totally covered!

#5 - Regular Maintenance


This is probably the one you don't want to hear, but it's true! Most often, routine care both daily and in the office are all that you need to keep you OUT of our chair!
